CARY

She was always a fighter.

The woman grimaces slightly.

CARY

DOCTOR

... We don't really know. Her higher functions are gone, but...

CARY

But she could be in pain.

DOCTOR

The doctor says nothing.

Cary takes the woman's hand. Leans in close.

CARY

(whispering)

Hey there... It's me. You don't have to fight anymore. It's okay... I'll be along soon. I promise... You can lose this one. It's okay.

Beat.

The woman's face relaxes. She sighs once. Dies.

CARY
