INT. KITCHEN - NIGHT

A party in progress. DARRELL (late 20s) is talking to MONICA (late 20s) when CHET (early 20s), deep in the two-fisted grip of a marijuana-ecstasy high, interrupts.

Chet holds up the album sleeve for Rush's "Moving Pictures".

CHET

Have you seen this, man? I just figured it out.

DARRELL

Yeah. It's "Moving Pictures" by Rush. It's great, but it's, like, 30 years old.

CHET

No. No. It's called "Moving Pictures," but look: there's, like, guys moving pictures, and there's these people here who're crying 'cause the pictures are moving.

(flips the album over)
And look, look: it's a movie crew,
making moving pictures.

(beat)

It's like a double entendre, but more than that. You know?

DARRELL

You mean a... triple entendre?

CHET

Dude! Yeah! It's like a <u>triple</u> entendre! Like one more than a double.

(beat)

Oh, whoa! I just had a thought: do you think there could be something more than a triple entendre?

DARRELL

Maybe a... quadruple entendre.

Chet gives Darrell a very warm hug.

CHET

(E-fueled sincerity)
Dude, seriously, I love your brain.
